They are the oldest and largest Irish cultural organizations in the U.S., with roots back 300 years to groups of the same name in Ireland.

The Order also has provided a continuous bridge to Ireland for those who are generations removed from our homeland. The AOH/LAOH sponsor many of the programs associated with promoting our Irish Heritage and our Catholic faith.
